We hope this month's newsletter finds all who read it doing well and if able, carrying concealed. Two training classes will be conducted by G.E.T.S. in October, a Basic Carrying Concealed Handgun Class on Saturday, October 13th, and an Advanced Carry Concealed Weapon Class on Saturday, Oct. 20th, 2012, in Homer, LA. The class on the 13th, as most of you know, is required for the process of applying for a carrying concealed permit from the LA State Police. The class on the 20th is not a requirement for obtaining a permit from LSP, however goes into depth a little more, no,...let's say a lot more that the basic CCH course. It could though, be used as a requirement for carrying concealed in your church with the Pastor's or governing person(s) approval. The course goes into and covers more of the five fundamentals of shooting, to when does those apply, definition of cover and concealment and shooting from behind both, shooting multiple targets, shoot ,or don't shoot and more. We have yet to find any one that was disappointed after completing that course. Due to the amount of time working with each participant in the advanced course, we do have to limit the size of the class to no more that fifteen.

The only requirement we have on the advanced class is that the participant must have in his/her possession, a current CCH permit from their state or attended one of G.E.T.S. CCH classes.

It has already happened in our country, many times. Who would have ever thought that teenagers and children would get shot while attending school?
