We began May's newsletter by remembering those that lost their lifes during the Boston Marathon Bombing last month. A little eight year boy, two adult females and a law enforcement officer had their lifes taken away by two coward and ruthless want-to-be terrorists brothers. One is talking to Bin Laden now in an infernal pit and the other should be joining him, but we will have to wait, hopefully not 10 -15 years from now. Our thoughts and prayers will continue to go out to the families of the above.

As Use of Force experts, we have no comments, suggestions or critisism on how the tragic ordeal was handled, but also as Use of Force experts, we know why and how somethings happened. How did a 29 year old femlae lose her life with no wounds to the upper body and no loss of limbs, but a man with two feet blown away survived the entire ordeal. It is a perfect example of why we consistly teach to fight, fight, and fight with every ounce of life you have, and you will survive. Never give up, never. You will know when it is time, don't let anyone else tell you it is over. The female most likely was deceased when she hit the ground from the force and concussion from the bomb. Have you ever had someone hit you so hard in the chest that it took your breath away for several seconds, leaving you gasping for air. Magnify that ten times and that is what individuals in the immediate area of the bomb experienced. Some stronger than others due to which way they were facing when the bomb went off. Trauma like that is so intense it can actually stop the heart, and when the heart stops, we stop. Perfect example is getting the wind knocked out of you. You are still able to move and gasp for air as the heart is still ticking.

The MIT Police Officer, Sean Collier, shot to death sitting in his vehicle. Left for work that day, not knowing what was going to happen that night to him. Shot down by the same two dirt bags that cowardly planted the two bombs three days before. We call them cowards, plus some other derogatory words, as that is what they are. They didn't have what it takes, skill, courage, bravery or the mindset to win. The only way they could ever win anything is cheat. And cheat is what they were best at. We know we may get some percussion back from using these terms in our newsletter but so be it. We would continue to call them what they are and those that truly know us, know that we will. They made the choice what they wanted to be, not us.

We are glad the horrible, tragic event is over. We are not happy with the fact that four, good, decent human beings lost their life. Me, (Steve Risner), and I don't know how Butch thinks, but I would of been perfectly fine if they used several bags to get the younger one out of the boat. We have always heard they have ways of making others talk. We would have found the truth, later yes, but we would have. I imagine they are a lot more folks that feel the same way I do.

We have talked about that tragic event with many others. I get upset sometimes when someone says, "How could God allow such a tragic thing, especially the taking of the life of a child." First, what everyone must understand is to not ever question God. I know that first hand and don't want to go into a sermon on our newsletter. Bad things happen and we live in

a cursed, fallen world. This is due to sin in general though not a direct consequence of any particular individual sin we may have committed. We will end this topic with something every one should know, or at least I do; God is God, we are not. God is the One (the only One) who determines what is right and what will be or not be. Our place is one of submission and obedience regardless of the pain, regardless of the confusion. We hope we do not lose too many clients with that being said. We teach something similar to the police officers and law enfrocement officers, when the critical incident comes. You do not have time to get your faith in order. Make in order before it comes and the rest will take care of itself. 2 Timothy 4:7 reminds us; "I have fought the good faith. I have finished the race, I have kept the faith".

We are looking to hold an Advanced Class in June. June the 29th. We have to consider the time it takes some to get the ammo. We have about another two months of this ammo shortage and it should be returning to the norm. Bet Boston, MA sold out of ammo in their stores. How great would it of been if a Carry Concealed Handgun permit carrier would of nailed one or both of those cowards? Bet that would of quited a bunch of fanatics.
