Anyone, especially CCH permit holders ,might be interested in attending this, as it covers some real good empty-hand techniques to protect you or someone else. For any age over 18. Course will also go over some easy to learn techniques for protecting someone from taking your firearm. A segment of the course will also provide those attendance with some great and simple to follow ways to stay safe and avoid being attacked. No ammunition needed for this course. Just register and show up and enjoy.
