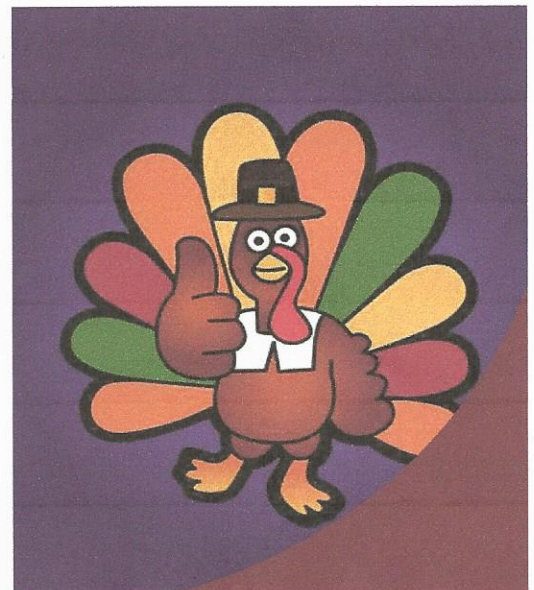
Basic CCH Class Nov. 8th

You may not like guns.

That is your right.

You may not believe in God.

That is your choice.

But if someone breaks into your home, the first two things you are going to do are...

1) Call someone with a gun

2) Pray they get there in time

How so true the above is. We have said many times in our training with law enforcement agencies that with police officers, there is no such thing as an Atheist. We justify that with the following; "In life or death critical situation, the police officer will believe in something and ask for that somethings protection. That alone does not make him an Atheist." How true that is anywhere though. One of the five factors that has proven to be so true in controlling "Survival Stress" (stress that is occuring during the critical event) is the "Faith Factor". The time to make right with God is not while the castrophic event is taking place. That should have already been in place long before the incident is happening. That way the Faith Factor will have been completed in handling "Survival Stress" for not only law enforcement but for everyone.

There was another firearms safety violation which resulted in a law enforcement officer being killed. Sept. 30th in the state of Pennsylvania during a training exerise. Four basic rules of firearms must be adhered to wherever you are and whatever you are doing; Treast all guns as if they are loaded; Point muzzle in safe direction; Keep finger off trigger until ready to fire and Be aware of your target surroundings. Not much details known but we would imagine they were either having live-fire exercises or simunition training. Thoughts and prayers go out the Officer's family and the Agency.

A month hardly now goes by without some type of a school shooting. We know you are aware of the latest one, Oct. 27th in the state of Washington. Three young lifes plus the young student shooter taken. Two or three others injured. The one before that on Sept. 30th in North Carolina. And whenever we mention to school administrators the thought of teachers carrying concealed they frown. Denial mode we call it. It is coming though and already being done in some places in th U.S. Okay, enough for this month. Stay Safe and remember to Carry Concealed!
