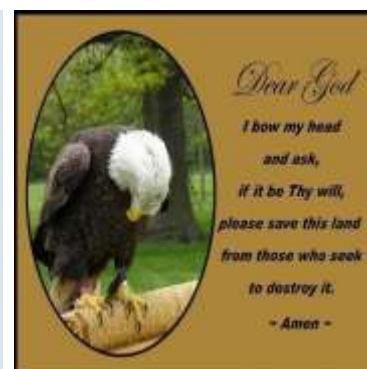

We have decided to offer our Advanced Carrying Concealed Weapons course more often in 2015 than we did in this upcoming past year. Our ACCW course not only provides excellent survival training but covers the requirements needed to obtain approval to carry concealed in church. The training also can fulfill your employer requisites to carry concealed while working. Not only does the course go over the fundamentals of shooting which is discussed in the basics CCH class, but covers in more detail those fundamentals of shooting from different distances or stages and also goes in more detail on Combat Point Shooting. The course also goes over shooting from cover, shooting while moving, decision making shooting and shoot /don't shoot. Reloading and loading is also conducted. The four basic rules of firearms safety is consistently stressed during the eight hour course. Participants are in the classroom the first 50 minutes and the remaining course time is out on the range. The cost of the course is the same as the basic CCH class however more ammunition is needed to go through that course, 300 rds. But it is well worth the cost of the ammunition. Those that have attended the course have given us high remarks on the course. We usually limit the class to only ten so that we can conduct the training on a more "one on one" basis. Watch for our dates on the ACCW course and give it a try. You won't be disappointed. We assure you that it will be well worth your time and extra cost for the ammunition.



HOW TO CARRY CONCEALED?

Now you have completed that basic Carrying Concealed Handgun class, sent off that packet to LSP and your permit comes in the mail. How do I carry concealed is a question that is asked to us many times. And we answer in the following way each time. How often do you want to carry concealed will depend a lot on how you want to carry concealed? Confused? Let's put it this way, if you are like we are and carry concealed every where we go, you want to carry that handgun concealed in a way that will be comfortable to you, not only conceal the handgun but be able to get to the handgun quickly and out, and be able to easily notice when the handgun is not being carried. There are many, no, a lot of holsters available in carrying concealed. Inside the pants, outside of pants, in a purse, in a pocket, shoulder holster, fanny pack or ankle holster. One of us has been carrying concealed on an ankle for almost 25 years now. Surely not the same holster but basically the same style. One has to decide first before carrying concealed how often are they going to carry concealed. That play's an important part in deciding how to carry concealed. There are many different manufactures of carrying concealed holsters on the market. You can go to the website of Bianchi, Safari, Uncle Mike or any of the others and find hundreds of different types of holsters. We don't recommend buying a holster online unless you are already familiar with what type you are getting.
