NEXT BASIC CCH AND CCW CLASS

Our next Basic Carrying Concealed Handgun Class and Advanced Carrying Concealed Weapons class is Saturday, April 25th, 2015 at the J.O. Whittington Firing Range at David Wade Correctional Center, Homer, LA. Either class is still \$62 and to be eligible to go through the Advanced class, one must either be currently in possession of a valid CCH permit or has previously attended one of GETS Carrying Concealed courses. Besides being on the range most of the entire time in the Advanced Class it does require a few more rounds of ammunition than the Basic CCH course. Instead of needing only 72 in the basic CCH class, one will need 250 to go through the Advanced course. We have noticed that ammunition is beginning to get a lot easier to purchase now; besides, in the Advanced course you shoot our ammo for the first hour. Most you have already met or have been in a class with a couple of our Staff Instructors and some of you have met all of our Staff Instructors. We want to just tell you a little bit about our Instructors and how they ran into us or us ran into to them. We will start with the one that has been with us the longest.

W.R. "Buster" Flowers

Buster, which is all we have ever known him by for 29 years and we actually don't know what the W.R. stands for, has been with us for nine years. I, (Steve Risner), first met Buster in 1986 in Minden during a drug bust. I was with Adult Probation & Parole and Buster was with the LSP Narcotics Division. Buster's partner back then was John Balance (now Sheriff of Bienville Parish). Buster has been dealing with the public not only with his twenty plus years with LSP but also in his current position with the Webster Parish School Board as Supervisor of Transportation and School Security. Buster at one time worked for a well-known local pro-basketball player's (Karl Malone) trucking company (Malone Enterprises Trucking Company). That was in Salt Lake City, UT and Buster got homesick and returned to Webster Parish when taking the position with Webster School Board. We have very much appreciated Buster's contribution to Golden Eagle and the Carrying Concealed classes. ONLINE APPLYING PROCESS

Applying online is somewhat easier and although you still have to scan and send some forms, you don't have to get your fingers dirty with two sets of finger print cards. Mailing application and forms in is still an option however and setting aside any additional forms required, anyone that completes our class on a Saturday can definitely put the entire packet in the mail to LSP on that Monday.
