SLIGHT INCREASE IN 2016

As we have mentioned in last month's Newsletter and in our ads for the Dec. 5th classes, we are forced to increase the fee for our 2016 classes. We are still though keeping it well under \$100 and the cheapest in the state. The fee for the Basic and Advanced courses in 2016 will now be \$77, a fifth-teen dollar increase. That will allow us to get better equipment and material to improve our courses and allow us to travel a little further that we did in 2015.

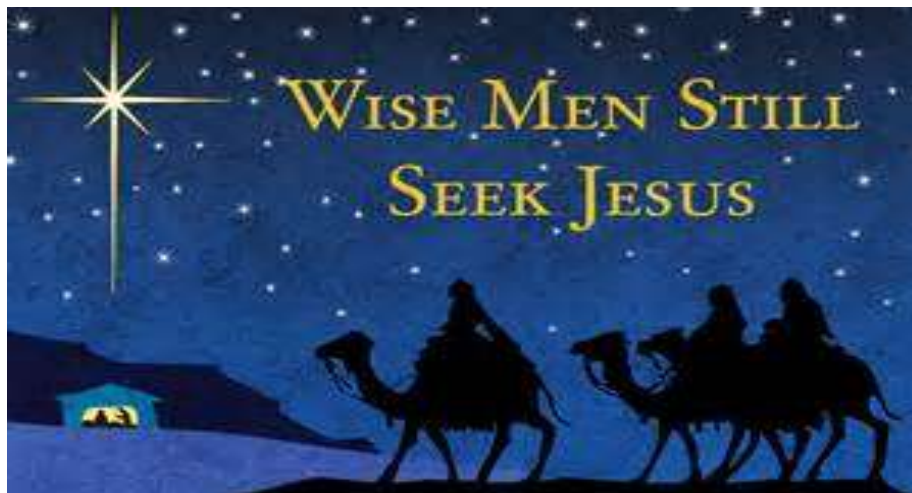
