Claiborne Parish Schools Dress Codes 2008-2009

ATHENS HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

PANTS, WALKING SHORTS, SKORTS and SKIRTS are permissible and may be either navy, khaki or black with belt loops

SKIRTS, SKORTS and WALKING SHORTS must be no more than three inches above the knee SHIRTS - may be either black, gold or white, must have a collar and may be either long or short-sleeved, pullover or button up. Shirts must be tucked in and a belt must be worn.

SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS and T-SHIRTS underneath a uniform must be a solid color - black, gold or white.

CARGO PANTS/SHORTS and CAPRI PANTS are NOT permissible.

Appropriate footwear must be worn.

CLAIBORNE ACADEMY UNIFORM POLICY

PANTS - navy or khaki, traditional dress pant with no logos

SHORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS, SKORTS, and CAPRI PANTS - K5-6th grades only - Long enough that skin cannot be touched by fingers when held to the side. Can be navy, khaki or school plaid.

SHIRTS - Solid red, navy or white. Must be a polo style with collar or solid dress shirt with collar, must have sleeves, no cap sleeves. Must be tucked in at all times. Must have solid navy polo style knit shirt with CA Crest Emblem.

SOCKS/TIGHTS - white, navy and red

BELTS - brown, black or navy. Must be worn when loops are available.

CASUAL DAY - Fridays - Jeans with a CA shirt purchased through Booster Club or other approved organizations may be worn.

PEP RALLY - CA shirt or sweatshirt with blue jeans.

SWEATSHIRTS/OUTER WEAR - must be neat and meet all other dress code guidelines. All garments worn underneath the layer of outerwear must meet all CA uniform and dress code guidelines.

HAYNESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

PANTS, WALKING SHORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS and SKORTS - navy, black or khaki - pants must not drag the floor, shorts cannot be oversized or longer than the kneecap or shorter than three inches above the knee, skirts and skorts must also be no longer than three inches above the knee. NO sweatpants, windpants, cargo pants or shorts, tear or zip away pants or any shorts or pants with extra pockets on the leg.

SHIRTS - white, black or gold (Tornado or LSU gold, not yellow), must have a collar and may be short or long sleeved, pullover or button-up. No t-shirts. No logos unless preapproved. Must be tucked in and present a neat appearance. Undershirts must be white in color and have no visible wording or logo that can be seen through uniform shirt. Black and gold school spirit may be worn as undershirts, no others allowed. School sponsored shirts designed by the ART department will be allowed to be worn as a uniform shirt.

SWEATSHIRT and SWEATERS/VESTS - Vest must be an approved solid color and worn over another school approved. White, black, gold. Grey may be worn only if it is a Haynesville School sponsored sweatshirt. No logos unless approved. Hoods on sweatshirts will not be allowed in any building at any time. Senior sweatshirts will be allowed.

COATS, JACKETS, WINDBREAKERS - of a solid approved school color, not excessive in length. An oversize flannel shirt is NOT a jacket and cannot be worn. Jackets and pullovers may be removed inside buildings. School sponsored groups (baseball, letterman, etc.) will be allowed. No denim. Solid brown, camo and leather must be approved by principal.

FOOTWEAR - white, brown, black with few accents colors. Solid colored socks that can be seen above shoe. Opaque hosiery is acceptable. No sandals, crocs or slides of any kind.

BELTS - required - black, brown or gold. No oversize belt buckles.

HEADWEAR - is not allowed.

PE UNIFORMS - shorts and t-shirts, no cutoffs.

HOMER ELEMENTARY UNIFORM POLICY

PANTS - navy or khaki, no oversize or sagging, No Dickies, logos or denim. Capris may be worn if not clingy or stretchy.

SHIRTS - white, purple or gold. Solid colors. Long or short sleeve with collar, polo style or button up (oxford), or turtleneck. Must be tucked in. Undershirts, jackets and sweaters must be solid purple, white or gold and logo free.

SKIRTS, JUMPERS, SKORTS and SHORTS - navy or khaki. No shorter than three inches above the knee

SOCKS/TIGHTS - Solid navy, white or khaki. No stripes or patterns.

BELTS - black, brown, navy. Pants with belt loops must have belt. Belt buckles cannot be over three inches and should not be distracting.

SHOES - Casual loafers (slip-on or lace-up), tennis shoes, sandals with a backstrap. No slides. No specific colors.

COATS/JACKETS - all heavy coats will be removed upon entering the buildings, will not be worn in hallways or classrooms. SWEATERS - must be school colors and can be worn indoors.

MOUNT OLIVE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL DRESS CODE

PANTS - khaki or navy 2-4 pocket pleated or flat front

BLUE JEANS - classic style, NO sagging jeans or pants, pipes, draw string pants, leggings or pants too tight

WALKING SHORTS - khaki or navy, no shorter than 2 in. above the knee

BLUE JEAN SHORTS - same guidelines as walking shorts

SKIRTS AND JUMPERS - khaki, navy or blue jean skirts or jumpers. No shorter than 2 in. above the knee (not skin tight) slits can be no higher than 2 in. above the knee

SHIRTS - white, red or navy, must have a collar, may be short or long sleeve, pullover (polo) or button up (oxford). Students will be sent home if their shirts are not long enough to tuck in. No exceptions.

CHAPEL ATTIRE - Wednesdays - khaki pants and white shirt. Girls may wear khaki skirts or jumpers with white shirt.

FOOT WEAR - must be appropriate - Absolutely no flipflops or flipflop style footwear.

FRIDAYs - T-shirt day, Christian or MOCS t-shirts only.

GENERAL - shirts are to be tucked in and belts worn at all times.

Elementary students with plaid uniform pieces from Inka may wear them. We have a relaxed dress code than most public schools now. Please DO NOT force us to go the strict dress code by not adhering to these guidelines.

SUMMERFIELD ELEMENTARY & HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

PANTS/CAPRIS - navy or khaki, no oversize pants, denim or jeans, sweatpants or windsuit pants. Pants may not be more than one size larger than waist size.

SHIRTS - red, navy or white, solid colors. Styles - Polo, oxford, turtlenecks. No logos unless otherwise approved by school. Must have sleeves and collars for grades 3-12. No denim. Must be tucked in at all times for grades 3-12. All undershirts must be red, white, gray or navy.

SKIRTS/JUMPERS/SKORTS - navy, khaki or plaids of red, white or navy. No denim. Skorts allowed only in grades pre-k to 5. Skirts, jumpers and skorts cannot be shorter than three inches above the knee.

SHORTS - navy or khaki. Cannot be shorter than three inches above knee. Allowed only in grades pre-k through 5. No denim.

COATS/JACKETS - Summerfield and Pineview issued varsity jackets for students issued jackets, no denim, no fleece pullovers, no flannel shirts. Solid colors of navy, red or white only.

SWEATERS/WINDBREAKERS/SWEATSHIRTS - red, white or navy. No denim. No logos unless approved.

SOCKS - red, white or navy. Solid colors only.

BELTS - black, brown, navy or red. Belts required for grades 3-12 in pants that have belt loops. SHOES - must have backs (straps), no flipflops or open toed shoes.

Teacher directed activities that concern dress other than policy may be followed. I.E. FBLA officer installation. Uniforms are mandatory.
